### **Pennant Captains Info Sheet**

All players compete at their own risk.

Ensure that all players know the VENUE and TIME of their matches. All matches must be played as per the draw.

Teams play in G.A. handicap order, lowest to highest. Exact GA handicaps determine playing order, but players play off their Daily handicap for the course being played.

Each team will consist of 8 players. Players will play in fours with 1 & 2s playing first.

- 1 & 2
- 3 & 4
- 5 & 6
- 7 & 8

Each team Captain is to print 2 copies of their team list. One copy is to be distributed to the starter and one copy to the opposing team no later than 15 mins prior to the match.

The GA handicaps are taken from Golf Genius. Golf Genius has set the handicaps as of the end of Thursday competitions. If a player's handicaps change from play on the Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, this will not be updated in Golf Genius.

Lists are to be exchanged with the Opposing Team Captain 15 minutes prior to the start of the first match.

No changes to the team are allowed after the exchange. Team Captains are advised to double check that handicaps GA are correct and that the total is at least 130.

Matches hit off at 7-minute intervals, with the exception of Magenta at 10min. intervals.

If only 7 players are available, the Opposing Team Captain must be notified as soon as possible. There is no obligation to specify which player will be absent. If only 7 players can play the lowest handicap player must play at position 1 and the following players in handicap order.

The team GA handicaps **including** the forfeiting players must be 130 or more.

If there are 4 or less players available this will be a full forfeit and will be a 8/0 loss.

Matches will be played, if possible, despite the weather conditions and will only be postponed if the course becomes unplayable.

On completion of matches, Team Captains must ensure that the results are correct and sign the results sheet.

Results must be emailed on completion of the matches to the CCWGA Pennant Co ordinator. This is the responsibility of the Club Official on Duty.

There is an official protocol for lodging a protest which must be followed otherwise it will not be recognised. Refer to the Pennant Terms of the Competition.

Captains of Host Clubs are required to provide at least one Official on Duty to start the field and to be in charge. It follows that this person needs to be someone with an understanding of the Rules of Golf and who is familiar with starting a competition. The person also needs to be able to make confident decisions in the event of a dispute or challenging situation.

Please ensure that all players have access to the R&A rules of Golf App.

Slow Play – Please remind your players that they must keep up with the pace of play.

### **Adding Teams to Golf Genius**

Captains will enter their teams into Golf Genius via the link prior to the commencement of the Pennant Season.

At the completion of each Match the Host Club Duty Officer will send result sheets to the CCWGA Pennant Co ordinator who will add the player names and results to Golf Genius.






Step 5. Select your team (you can only change your own team)




#### Step 6. Adding your players.

From this page you will be able to select your team. You can either select the player from "choose player" drop down box or add a brand new player.




### Add players details, save and then click done.




Step 7. Adding via the drop down box.

Select the top box on the left. You will see the selected box is orange.




Step 8. Click on the drop-down box > Choose a player and select the player from the team drop down box and Click on > Go.




You can swap players using drag and drop.
